THE PARABLES OF JESUS

Led by Pastor Symmank, in the 8th Grade Classroom.

Forty-three parables are recorded in the four Gospel accounts, mostly in Matthew and Luke. All speak about the "Kingdom of God" or the "Kingdom of Heaven" -- God's rule in the lives of His believers. They are meant to illustrate how that which is heavenly is similar, or dissimilar, to the way things are viewed from our earthly perspective. And sometimes they are even meant to obscure the meaning from those who do NOT accept the key to their understanding which is Jesus Himself. Some parables are simple to understand, others need literary and cultural understandings to uncover their meaning. Come join Pastor Symmank for this exciting journey into the stories Jesus told.
